With reference to G.O., No. 279, Educational, dated 11th April 1908, I have the honour to submit herewith two separate joint applications signed by me and the Principal of the College of Engineering, one for vesting the Francis Cotton Walker Scholarship Endowment in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments Act VI of 1890, and the other for settling a scheme for the administration of the endowment.

2. Two separate draft notifications on the subject prepared by the Government Solicitor, Madras, are also submitted for the approval of Government and for publication in the *Fort St. George Gazette*.

3. Under rule 5 of the present rules the scholarship holder shall be required to pay the tuition and other fees prescribed by the College rules. The Government Solicitor says that it is neither necessary nor proper to insert this rule in the scheme.

2. From G.O., No. 370, dated 7th December 1864, it appears that the original endowment consisted of Government 5 per cent. pro-notes to the nominal value of Rs. 4,000. The annual income was given as a lump scholarship of Rs. 200.

From Dr. Duncan's letter on page 1 of G.O., No. 322, Educational, dated 15th May 1893, it would seem that the pro-notes were subsequently converted to $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., thence to 4 per cent., and now stand at $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., the annual income having thus fallen to Rs. 140. The preamble to the rules with G.O., No. 322, Educational, dated 15th May 1893, states that the "present value of the scholarship is about Rs. 13 per mensem, presumably up to date the entire amount of the interest has been paid by way of scholarship without any balance being left over, as no cash balance is shown in the notification. The present nominal value of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. securities is Rs. 4,500 and the interest thereon is Rs. 157-8-0. The present scheme fixes the scholarship at Rs. 13 per mensem or Rs. 156 per annum leaving a surplus of Rs. 1-8-0 for investment under rule 9.

2. The Director of Public Instruction may be asked to state definitely u o. in consultation with the Accountant-General if necessary—

(a) When the face value of the Government pro-notes was converted from Rs. 4,000 to Rs. 4,500.

(b) Whether the full amount of interest has hitherto been paid by way of scholarship, or whether no petty cash balance remains.

OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

The endowment of Rs. 4,000 was supplemented in August 1896 by a sum of Rs. 500 sent to the Accountant-General by the Principal of the Engineering College. This seems to have been accumulated interest but I have not yet got the details—perhaps they are unimportant for the present purpose. I shall get them later for record, and shall see that the College calendar is corrected (page 151).

2. The full amount of interest has hitherto been paid to the Principal by way of scholarship. The Accountant-General has no cash balance at present to the credit of the endowment. The last half year's interest order has been cashed.
