ANNEXURE.

It is interesting to note that the total number of publications received and registered during the period under report is the largest ever recorded in a single quarter since the Book Registration Act XXV of 1857 came into operation.

2. The total number of publications registered during the quarter is 499 which may be classified thus—

3. Distributed according to languages, English has contributed 157 works with diglot editions; Tamil 133; Telugu 80; Malayalam 13; Canarese 13; Uriya 2; Hindustani 37; Arabic 20; Persian 2; and Sanskrit 42, printed in Telugu, Grantha and Dévanāgarī characters.

4. Of the total number of works registered, more than 16 per cent, are designed for educational purposes.

5. It is also gratifying to report that the total number of works copyrighted during the quarter under notice has reached the highest figure of 163. Of these, twelve Government publications have been registered free of charge.
