Sr,

I have the honour to state that the post of the Junior typist on Rs. 20-1-25 in my office has fallen permanently vacant and there are no passed candidates in the District to fill the post. Anticipating this vacancy I published an advertisement in the Fort Saint George Gazette dated 14th January 1908 and two succeeding issues inviting applicants for the post. In pursuance of this advertisement six applications have been received but only one of them is a duly qualified candidate. This man has since got an appointment in the Collector's Office, Vizagapatam.

2. Akkaraju Suryaprasadarao, typist on Rs. 15 in the Division office, Narsapur, has been acting as the junior typist in my office since February 1906. He has passed the Middle school examination in the 3rd class and typewriting Test - Elementary grade and also the theoretical portion - of the Intermediate grade. He is going to appear for the practical test of the Intermediate grade on the 19th instant. As he has not passed the qualifying general educational - examination, viz, Matriculation and Hand-writing and dictation test, he is not eligible for confirmation in the post unless exempted by Government. He was already exempted - from the Examination rules temporarily three times by the Board of Revenue. He has been working in my office very satisfactorily and is as good as any passed candidate. He has nearly six years service as a typist in Revenue offices. As there are no passed candidates available to fill up the vacant post, and in view of his good work in this office, I should like to confirm him in the post as he well deserves

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it. I therefore request that Government may be pleased to exempt him permanently from the examination rules to hold a typist's post in the Collector's office.

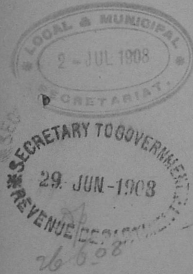

The Collector of Kistna (Mr. Morris) requests the permanent exemption from the Upper Secondary examination of A. Suryaprakasa Rao for employment as the Junior typist on Rs 20-1-25 in his office.

2. It is stated that the vacancy was advertised in three issues of the Fort St George Gazette and, among the ^{that} Candidates who applied for the post only one was duly qualified. He has since got an appointment in the Vizagapatam Collectorate. As there are no passed Candidates available and in view of the good work done by Suryaprakasa Rao, the Collector recommends his exemption.
