I have the honour to state that one Palaparti Seshayya,
a clerk in the Ellore Division, who passed the old General Test,
Vernacular Branch, was appointed in 1890 as a Taluk clerk on Rs.
15. When Mr. Garstin's scheme was introduced in the year 1899,

he

he was given a post carrying a pay of Rs.17½ in the Taluk office. He was subsequently promoted to a substantive Rs.20 post in 1904 and also to an acting appointment on Rs.30 in 1907.

2. Under note (2) to paragraph 1 of the Public service Notification published at page 92 of the Fort Saint George Gazette, dated 19th. January, 1893, Seshayya was not eligible for promotion after 31st. December, 1893. His promotion to a Rs.17½ ^{post} in Mr. Garstin's scheme was, however, valid under paragraph 6 of Government Order No.624 Rev., dated 14th. November, 1896. But in giving the subsequent promotions the notification of 1892 seems to have been over-looked by the Divisional Officer, as he made no application then for exempting Seshayya from the Examination rules.

3. On finding this mistake, the acting appointment on Rs.30 which Seshayya was holding has been cancelled. But in view of the fact that he has been holding, though against rules, a substantive Rs.20 post since 1904 and in view of his capabilities to hold the post and of his long service, I am reluctant to cancel the substantive appointment on Rs.20. Further, he will attain the age of 55 years on 1st. July, 1908 and will be retired on 2nd. July, 1908. It will be a great hardship and loss in emoluments to him, if he is now reduced to Rs.17½. On the other hand, there will be no harm in allowing the promotion to stand for a few days more. I therefore, request that Government may be pleased to sanction the permanent exemption of Seshayya from the examination rules, to hold posts carrying a salary of Rs.20 from August 1904.

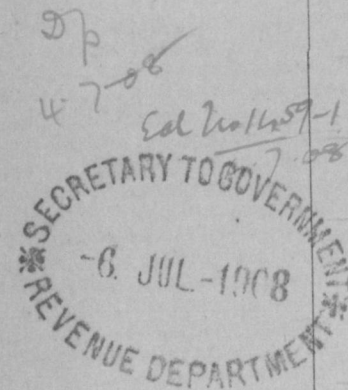
