I have the honour to inquire if any grant will be made during 1908-1909 from Provincial funds for the construction of school buildings.

Order—No. 536, Educational, dated 14th July 1908.

The President, District Board, Anantapur, will be informed that no grant will be made from Provincial funds to District Boards for the construction of new school buildings during the current year. The special grant of six lakhs, from which allotments were made in previous years, has disappeared with the introduction of the existing Provincial settlement, and has already been fully absorbed by charges of a permanent recurring nature in connection with the improvement of elementary education.

[SUBJECT.—Enquiring if any grant will be made during 1908-1909 for the construction of school buildings.]

From E. Scott, Esq., President, District Board, Anantapur, dated 10th June 1908, No. 112.

In the Civil Budget Estimate for 1908-1909 a sum of Rs. 3.83 lakhs is provided under the head 22-E. Education (iv) "payment in support of Local Board Elementary schools, etc.," and a sum of Rs. 7.11 lakhs is entered against "Contribution to Local Boards (subsidies)" under 22-I. Education. The total provision on account of Board schools in the civil budget estimate is thus Rs. 10.94 lakhs.

2. In passing orders on the District Board budget for 1908-1909, the Government have distributed the amount as shown in the statement of the Director of Public Instruction on page 8 of the notes. It does not appear therefore that funds are available for contribution towards the construction of school buildings during the current year.

3. It is for consideration whether the President, District Board, Anantapur, may be informed with the concurrence of the Educational Department that no grant will be made from Provincial funds for the construction of school buildings during the current year.

FINANCIAL DEPARTMENT.

The special grant of six lakhs disappeared with the introduction of the existing Provincial settlement on the 1st April 1908 and if anything is to be said on the point to the President of the District Board it would be more correct to say this than to retain the second sentence in the Educational draft order. The present settlement is based on the budget estimate for 1907-1908 not that of 1908-1909 (Educational office-note, dated 24th June 1908). When a revised Provincial settlement is introduced it is not possible to point to any previously earmarked grant as having been devoted to a particular object in the new settlement. The settlement is a consolidated settlement and not a settlement for items of charge and it is submitted that it is no more possible now to trace the six lakhs grant than it was to trace the 8 lakhs grant in 1905-1906 (please see correspondence in G.O., Nos. 277, 278, Educational, dated 9th May 1907).
