In his Proceedings R.C.No.2137 of 1908, dated 1st April 1908, the D.P.I. granted extraordinary leave without pay for a period of five months and 24 days to Mr. A.V.J. Vas, Junior Assistant Professor, Presidency College, in continuation of <sup>the</sup> furlough for one year *already granted to him.*

2. As Mr. Vas was on long leave in Europe, the grant of the further leave by the D.P.I. was irregular; *It* would have been more in accordance with the prescribed procedure if <sup>the D.P.I.</sup> ~~he~~ had informed Mr. Vas that the Government of Madras had no objection to the latter's making application to the Secretary of State for the grant of the leave - vide Article 237(a) of the C.S.R. The attention of the D.P.I. is drawn to this irregularity.

3. The grant of the leave in question has been confirmed by the Secretary of State.
