Sir,

In their order No. 178 Educational., dated 11th March 1908, Government were pleased to sanction payment, during the last official year, of special grants to certain European Schools on submission of the necessary vouchers. All the schools drew their grants before the expiry of the year except the St. Joseph's Boarding Institution, Coonoor, of which the Correspondent failed to submit all the necessary vouchers. He now submits them amounting to Rs. 630/- and requests payment of a grant of Rs. 315/-. In regard to the delay, he explains that he did submit in time the necessary vouchers which the Inspector says, however, he did not receive. The Inspector recommends, nevertheless, payment of the grant as the management have incurred the expenditure and it would be hard if grant should be now withheld. In

In G.O. 178 Edl d, 11th March 1908 the Govt sanctioned the payment in the last financial year to the St. Joseph's Boarding Institution, Coonoor, of a special grant of Rs 337, under Art. 44 of the Code of Regulations for European Schools.

2. The D.O. I now reports that the Correspondent of the School failed to submit the vouchers and to draw the money before the expiry of the last financial year, but that he now submits vouchers amounting to Rs 630 and requests that a grant of Rs 315 may be sanctioned. As regards delay the Correspondent ^{explains} ~~states~~ that he did submit the vouchers in time, which, the Inspector says, he did not receive. The Inspector, nevertheless, considers that it will be hard to withhold the grant and recommends that the payment may, as a special case, be made during the current year. The D.O. I agrees with the Inspector.

3. It is submitted that the Financial Department may be consulted u.o. as to whether there is any account objection to the acceptance of the Director's proposal.

The sanction accorded in G.O. No. 178 Edl dated 11th March 1908, was limited to the year 1907-08.
