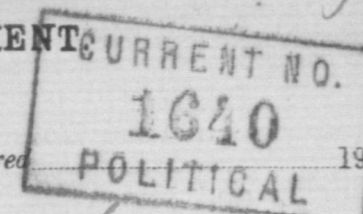

Sir,

I have the honour to forward for the favourable consideration of Government, the application of S. Rama bhai Ammani, praying for exemption of her son N. Raghunatha Rao Sahib from the operation of the Examination rules to enable him to enter Government service. The applicant is the niece of Her Highness the late Kamakshiamba Bhai Sahib, the Senior Rani of the late Raja of Tanjore and is in receipt of a political pension of Rs 10 per month, which is all the income the family has to depend on. The family consists of her husband (not capable of earning anything), two sons including Raghunatha Rao referred to, an unmarried daughter and the petitioner. Raghunatha Rao is now 20 years old, has

has passed the Lower Secondary Examination held in December 1902, and has read up to the VI form. From the certificate granted to him by the Principal of the school he seems to have been a studious youth.

Most respectfully Showeth:

That Your Excellency's humble applicant was a dependant relation of H.H.M. the Late Kamakshiamba Bhai Saheb, and, as such, has been ⁱⁿ receipt of a pension of Rs 10 per month, since the demise of Her Highness.

That this poor monthly pension is the only means of subsistence to the applicant and her family, comprising her aged husband, two sons, and a daughter, she having no ancestral property or any other source of income.

That, being unable to maintain her large family with the income of Rs 10 referred to above, Your Excellency's applicant is exposed to all the hardships of destitution, without money and without credit in the bazaar.

That for these reasons, the applicant is constrained, with unspeakable regret, to compel her eldest son, N. Ragunatha Rao Saheb, to discontinue his studies while he was making good progress in them, till the end of 1906 when he was a student in the Matriculation Class. This will be seen from the testimonia of the Rev. W.H. Blake, the Principal of the Local S.P.G. College.

That, with a view to be relieved, in some measure, of the growing anxieties of her family, Your Excellency's humble applicant is desirous to secure some employment to her son, N. Ragu-natha Rao sahib, who is now twenty years old.

In these circumstances, the applicant begs permission to implore your Excellency to be so gracious as to sympathise in her grievous and helpless condition, and grant her son, named above, the necessary exemption in respect of Examination Rules to enable him to join any Government Service. This help, the applicant respectfully begs to represent, will greatly mitigate the distress of her present condition.

The Collector of Tanjore (Mr. Bedford) forwards for the favourable consideration of Government an application of S. Rama Bhai Ammani, niece of Her Highness the late Kamakshiamba Bhai Sahib, the Senior Rani of the late Raja of Tanjore, requesting that her son, Raghunath Rao may be exempted from the Upper Secondary examination so as to enable him to

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under Government Service.

2. The Collector does not, however, state whether he will provide Raghunatha Rao with an appointment or whether it is intended that a general exemption is required to enable Raghunatha Rao to seek employment in any department. ^{In} ~~the~~ ^{case,} the latter, the application should be submitted through the head of the department who wishes to employ Raghunatha Rao.

3. It is for Consideration whether the Collector may be requested to state whether he will provide Raghunatha Rao with an appointment, and if so, on what pay and whether the general exemption of ⁸¹ Raghunatha Rao from the Upper Secondary Examination is desired or only exemption with reference to any post or class of appointments.
