Mr. Smith joined his appointment in the Presidency College on 4. 10. 07.

2. The permission is required under para. 1 of G.O. 615 dt 19. 9. 06 which says that the S.O. 9 should obtain the previous approval of Government to the period of vacation for which it is proposed to close any Government College and that he should see that no educational officer proceeds to Europe during the vacation without the prior sanction of Government.

3. Proposals as to the dates of closing and reopening of the Govt. Colleges for the summer vacation of 1909 have not yet been received. For the summer vacation of 1908 the Presidency College was closed on the 8th May 1908 (inclusive) and reopened on the 13th July 1908.
