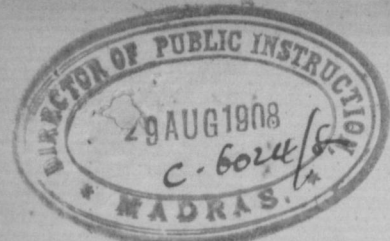

SIR,

I have the honor herewith to forward plan & estimate for extra seats to Boys' School Latrine at a cost of Rs 2,020, and to request that Government may be pleased to sanction the necessary expenditure from school funds.

2. The plan & estimate were approved by the Committee in Resolution 11 of meeting dated 18th August 1908.

3. At present, the latrine attached to the upper school of the Male Branch has only 16 seats for 240 boys. The Committee, after a careful consideration of the recommendation of the Civil Surgeon, are of opinion that, at least 30 are necessary.

Plans and estimates for providing extra seats to the Boys' Latrine at the Lawrence Asylum, Ootacamund.

The Committee of the Lawrence Asylum, Ootacamund, submits plans and estimates for providing extra seats to the Boys' Latrine at a cost of Rs 2020 and requests the sanction of Govt to ^{carry out} the work ^{at the cost of} ~~being carried out~~ from the funds of the Asylum.

2. In memo. no. 2580-1 Edl dated 8th Nov. 1907 printed on page 12 of G.O. no. 184 W. & 7th Feb. 1908, sanction was accorded to the construction from the Asylum funds of a latrine and urinal for the boys at a cost of Rs 2,820. This latrine provided only 16 seats for 240 boys. ^{which} The Medical Officer of the Asylum, Major Illington considers ^{that 16 seats are} ~~to be~~ ^{Suggests that the Committee should insist on} totally inadequate and ~~insisted that~~ ^{being} at least 30 seats ~~should be~~ ^{should} provided. The plans now submitted accordingly provides ^{for} 14 additional seats.

3. As regards the question of funds, the current year's budget of the Male Branch is expected to close with a surplus balance of Rs 8,954 - vide page 6 of G.O. no. 240 Edl D 27-3-08. An expenditure of Rs 300 on sports and special treat to children in connection with the 50th Anniversary of the

opening of the Asylum has been sanctioned in G.O. no. 669 Edl & 19-9-08. The Committee has further applied for the sanction of Govt to an expenditure of Rs 320 for providing Swing ventilators to the large dormitory in the Boys' school; to the purchase at an approximate cost of Rs ⁴²⁰ ~~240~~ of ^{two} Horbury's Patent Latrines; and to the payment of a gratuity of Rs 1,800 to Mr. Madolore late Headmaster of the Male Branch. (including the expenditure of Rs 2,020 applied for in this case, as per All these items ~~total up to~~ Rs 4,860 and if all these are sanctioned, there will still be a balance ~~Sanction~~ of Rs 4,094 [Rs 8,954 - Rs 4,860] on the Male Branch side of the Asylum Budget.

4. In these circumstances the execution of the work from the funds of the Asylum may be sanctioned. The draft below is for approval.
