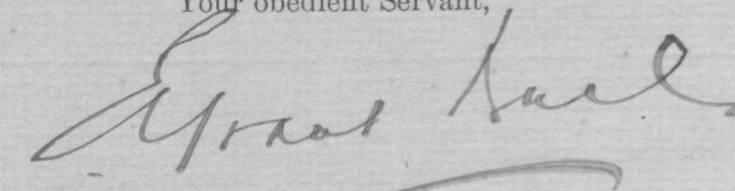
With reference to your letter No. 375 R. dated 5th September,

I have repeatedly ordered that 3 clear months should be allowed ~~from~~ probable date of receipt of despatch - or say 4 months from date of Indent.

It is submitted that in this case, the latest date within which the stores were expected to reach India was fixed as 31st December 1908, which is 3 months & 25 days from the date of the indent. ⁽⁵⁻⁹⁻⁰⁸⁾ The indent was despatched by the home mail of the 10th September, and would have reached the India by the end of that month, from which date three clear months, that is, up to 31st December 1908, were allowed for complying with the indent.

The indent is said to have reached the India office on the 28th September 1908, from this date to the 31st December 1908 is more than three months.
