Why moral?

In forwarding a free distribution list of Mr. Lefroy's book on "the Indian Insect Pests", the Inspector-General of Agriculture in India allotted 50 Copies for the Director of Public Instruction, Madras, including the Copies required for distribution among selected members of the Educational Department. The I. G. of Agriculture also stated that "if any additional Copies are required they can be obtained on payment from the Government Press."

2. At the instance of the Inspector of Schools, 1st Circle, the D. P. I. now requests that arrangements may be made with the Govt. of India for the supply of 32 additional Copies of the book for distribution among the Assistant and Sub-Assistant Inspectors of Schools of the 1st Circle as the Inspector considers that the book will be of great use in enabling them to develop moral instruction in Schools with gardens.

3. As the additional Copies required can be obtained on payment from the Govt. Press, it is not clear why the D. P. I. has come up to Government with his application for them. It is for consideration whether the D. P. I. may be informed that he may get ~~the~~ Copies of the book on payment from the Govt. Press or whether application may be made to the Govt. of India for Copies of the book free of cost.
