Sir,

With reference to G.O. No. 746 Educational dated 7th instant declining to sanction the appointment of assistant examiners to assist the Board of Examiners, College of Engineering, at the ensuing examination, I have the honour to state that the President of the Board informs me that the Principal, College of Engineering, asked him on the 24th August last to set the question papers for the ensuing examination which should commence on the 7th December and that on the return from leave of Mr. R.L. Jones who is a permanent member of the Board, in September, he submitted as usual his proposals regarding the appointment of assistant examiners. As sufficient time had to be allowed for setting the question ^{papers} and as all the persons proposed as assistant examiners were the same as those appointed by Government last year, the President anticipated the sanction of Government and distributed some of the work among them. The

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question papers have accordingly now been set and I beg to recommend, in these circumstances, that the work done by the Assistant examiners so far may be allowed to stand and that they may be allowed remuneration for it. The marking and other work to be done hereafter in connection with the examinations will be entrusted to the college staff.

A statement of the work done by the assistant examiner will be obtained and submitted later.

The favour of very early orders is requested.

C. No. 2493 From the D. P. I. No. 6655, dated 19-11-1908.

SUBJECT.

Recommending that the work done by the Assistant Examiners previous to the receipt of G.O. no. 746 Edl dated 7th Nov. 1908 may be allowed to stand.

Please see G.O. no. 746 Edl dated 7th Nov. 1908 and the notes therewith.

2. In that order the Govt. declined to sanction the appointment of assistant examiners to assist the Board of Examiners of the College of Engineering and said that the work which it was proposed to entrust to assistant examiners should be distributed among the members of the College staff.

3. The D. P. I. now reports that in September last, the President of the Board of Examiners had, in anticipation of the sanction of Govt, distributed the work of setting some of the question papers among the assistant examiners and that some of the papers have accordingly been set by them. The Director therefore recommends that the work done by the Asstt. Examiners so far, may be allowed to stand and that they may be allowed remuneration for it. He says that the marking and other work to be done hereafter will be entrusted to the College Staff.

4. In the circumstances, the D. P. I.'s recommendation may, it is submitted, be accepted.
