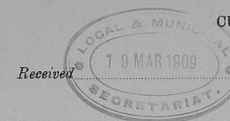

My dear Elwin,

Some Muhammadans at Rajahmundry requested His Excellency that Hindustani Munshis should be provided in the High Schools of the Godavari District. His Excellency told them that he could not undertake to appoint Munshis where the number of Muhammadans in the School was small. His Excellency was informed that at Rajahmundry itself a Hindustani Munshi was employed at the College and it was suggested that his services might perhaps be made available for other High Schools in Rajahmundry. I am desired to ask you to inform the Muhammadans who made those representations that His Excellency ^{has} consulted the Director of Public Instruction and learns from him that there is only one High School at Rajahmundry other than that attached to the Training College and that the Director has ascertained that the Committee of that School have not made any proposal for utilising the services of the Hindustani Munshi of the Government College Rajahmundry. The Director further reports that the Government College Munshi has as much work as he can do properly at the Arts College and the Training College.
