Sr,

I have the honour to state that G. Greenivasa Rao, clerk in the Head Assistant Collector's office, Bhadrachalam who has passed the Lower Secondary Examination requests that he may be permitted to appear for the Revenue Test Lower and Account^{est} Lower.

2. Greenivasarao is a native of Bhadrachalam and passed the Lower Secondary Examination, the highest standard in the school established by Government in that place. He says that he could not execute his ^{studies} further as schools containing higher classes are at a distance of more than 100 miles from that place and as the means of communication are extremely difficult.

3. He is the permanent 4th clerk of the Head Assistant Collector's office, Bhadrachalam on 4:20 and --- acting 3rd clerk of the same office on 4:25. He is a non-brahman and has put in about 9 years service, all of which He has spent in the Agency. He worked as ^{Camp} clerk under several Divisional Officers touring with them in the worst parts of the Agency. Mr. Tampoe, the present Head Assistant Collector, Bhadrachalam, states that the clerk is a man of considerable ability in spite of the poor education he has received and that his work is uniformly good.

4. I consider the petitioner deserves encouragement and recommend that the permission applied for may be granted.

The Collector of Godavari (Mr. F.B.Elwin) recommends that G. Srinivasa Rao, permanent fourth clerk on Rs 20 and acting third clerk on Rs 25 in the Head Assistant Collector's Office, Bhadrachalam, may be permitted to appear for the Account and Revenue tests, Lower grade.

2. Srinivasa Rao has passed only the Lower Secondary examination. He appears, however, to have been appointed to a post on Rs 25 under item I of Column B of Article 2(2) of the Public Service Notification which excludes appointments in the Agency tracts of Ganjam, Vizagapatam and Godavari from the operation of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification. Under Article 4 of the Special Test Notification Srinivasa Rao cannot appear for any of the special tests unless specially permitted by Government to do so, although note (3) to that Article permits any person holding any superior appointment in the Agency tracts of Ganjam, Vizagapatam and Godavari to appear for the Criminal Judicial test, Lower grade, for the purpose of qualifying himself to hold any appointment in these tracts. It is not stated whether Srinivasa Rao has taken advantage of the concession and passed this test, before applying for permission to appear for the

Account and Revenue, Lower, tests. These two tests ^{alone} qualify a man for the posts of Revenue Inspectors and Head Clerks in Revenue Divisional Offices and the petitioner apparently wants to qualify for these posts.

3. The Collector's recommendation in favour of Srinivasa Rao, is based on the following grounds:--

(1) Srinivasa Rao could not prosecute his studies further than the Lower Secondary standard as schools containing higher classes are at a distance of more than 100 miles from his place and the means of communication are extremely difficult.

(2) He is a non-Brahmin and has put in a service of about 9 years, all of which he has spent in the Agency tracts.

(3) He is a man of considerable ability in spite of the poor education he has received and his work is uniformly good.

4. Unpassed men are not ordinarily permitted to appear for any special tests - vide Hon'ble Member's orders on page 16 of G.O.No. 775, Educational, dated 17th November 1908. But in view of the fact that Srinivasa Rao has passed the Lower Secondary examination and that the service of about 9 years put in by him has all been spent in the ^{Agency} ~~Agency~~ tracts, it is for consideration whether he may be permitted to appear for the Account and Revenue tests, Lower grade, as a special case.

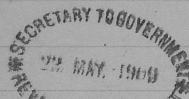

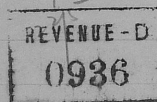

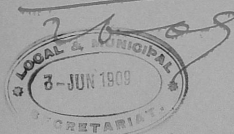
