The Accountant-General reports that Mr. J. J. Logan
Inspector of Schools, (now on leave) attains the age of 55 on the
3rd January 1910. The S. P. 9 states that it is the intention of
Mr. Logan to retire from service from that date and re-
commends that his retirement with effect from 3rd January
1910 may be permitted.

2. Mr. Logan is on combined privilege leave and furlough
for two years with effect from the 3rd January 1908. Mr.
Herbert Champion is acting for him. Under his agreement
with the Secretary of State Mr. Champion's present engagement
is only for a term of two years. But under para. 6 of the
agreement the Govt. can retain his services if they ^{wish to do so}.

The question of appointing a successor to Mr. Logan does not
however ^{at present} appear to arise. His retirement from 3rd January 1910
may, therefore, be permitted. Cf. G. O. No. 371 Ed., dt. 13th June 1907
for a precedent.
