The applicant has passed the Senior Local Examination of the Cambridge University and under article 1 of the Public Service Notification and G.O No 288 Educational dated 26 May 1910, he is qualified to enter public service until 15th April 1911. Apparently he has not succeeded yet in securing any appointment in public service.

2. M.K. Padiyar now requests that he maybe permitted to appear for the Civil Judicial Test and the Criminal Judicial Test. ~~He~~ ^{As he} has passed only the Senior Local Examination he cannot under article 4 of the Special Tests Notification appear for the above tests except with the special permission of Government. It is for consideration whether the permission sought for

I am not quite sure that the above note is correct. It was a provision as follows? Up to April 1st next the man is in the position of having passed an exam. recognized in Art. 1 of the P.S. Act as a sufficient qualification for entering the Public Service. Therefore at present he is eligible to appear for the Civil Judicial Test. But if he does not get an appl. by April 1st he will no longer be eligible for the Public Service, & as the next Special Test exam. is not till Oct. his eligibility for appearing in it is conditional on his getting an appl. in a public Service before April 1st.

2. He is not an under note (2) to Rule 4 of the Special Test Notification eligible to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test nor will he be so eligible even if he gets an appl. by

April 1st next. It seems rather hard that he sh^d be ruled out under this rule, but such is the position.

Please examine again & say if this above is correct.

The applicant is qualified to enter the public service till 1st April 1911 (Vide G.O. N^o. 288 Educational dated 26th May 1909). Under rule 4 of the Special Test notification he will be eligible until that date to appear for Special Tests, irrespective of his getting an appointment in the public service. After 1st April 1911, the applicant will not be eligible for entering the public service, and will not be qualified to appear for special tests, even though he might have secured an appointment in the public service before that date, ^{as} he will not possess the qualification for entering for ^{the} Special test at the time of applying for that Examination which is in July.

2. As regards ^{the} Criminal Judicial Test, the ^{applicant} is not eligible to appear for that examination under note (2) to
