My dear Mr. Wynch,

Professor Taira Shidehara of the Imperial University of Tokyo, Japan, has called upon the Hon'ble Mr. Butler and wishes for facilities for seeing schools in Madras. He will probably arrive at Madras on the 14th February next and will, it appears, call on the Principals of the Government Colleges there. I am desirous to say that the Government of India will be glad with the permission of His Excellency the Governor in Council, the usual facilities are placed at the disposal of the professor to enable him to see educational institutions in Madras. I am to suggest that if possible a ^{European} Government officer might be directed to accompany him upon his inspection and help him.
