He had continued his studies up to the Matriculation Class but owing to adverse circumstances he was unable to proceed further and his educational qualifications now consist only of a pass in the Lower Secondary Examination. According to the rules now in force, he very much regrets, he is not eligible for promotion to posts carrying a salary of more than twenty rupees in the superior service. Though he has the capacity and aptitude for better and higher appointments, want of higher educational qualifications has most unfortunately become an insuperable barrier to
