Sir,

Mr. P.F. Fyson, Professor of Biology, Presidency College reports that the series of coloured illustrations known as Curtiss' Botanical Magazine, which is issued by the Director of Royal Garden, Kew and was hitherto taken in at the Government Central Museum, Madras is to be discontinued at the latter institution, that the Magazine would be of great use to the Presidency College as affording aids in the identification of plants, and that he did not suggest its supply to the College earlier owing to the great cost of purchasing the back numbers as without them the series would not be of any use. Now that it has been proposed to discontinue the magazine at the Central Museum Mr. Fyson is anxious to avail himself of this opportunity to have the series continued at the Presidency College and requests that arrangements may be

made either for the transfer or loan to the College of the back numbers in the Connemara Library attached to the Museum where they can be of little use. The Principal Librarian of the Connemara Library has no objection to the proposed transfer, but notes that the sanction of Government would be necessary for it. I have the honour accordingly to request that sanction may be accorded first to the transfer of the back numbers ending with No. 1498 for December 1911 which I understand from the above Librarian closes Volume VII of the fourth series or Volume 137 of the whole work, and secondly to the supply of the series beginning with the next volume to the Presidency College.

2. The cost of this series is stated to be £ 2-2-0 per annum and as partial set-off against this extra expenditure it is proposed by the Professor of Biology and the Principal to discontinue the supply of the following journals to the Presidency College:-
