I have the honour to submit herewith the printed catalogue of books registered in the Madras Presidency during the fourth quarter of 1911, with the following report on the catalogue.

2. The publications received and registered during the quarter are 996 in all, being less by only three than the figure of the previous quarter which terminated on the 30th September 1911. Of these, 628 are grouped as "Books" and 368 as "Periodicals."

3. The classification of the collection in accordance with the languages shows that English including diglot editions has contributed 262 works, Latin 1, Italian 1, Tamil 320, Telugu 198, Malayalam 39, Kanarese 36, Uriya 15, Hindustani 11, Arabic 24, Persian 3 and Sanskrit 86 comprising those published in Telugu, Malayalam, Kanarese, Grantha and Nāgāri characters.

4. A little more than 9 per cent. of the total number registered consists of works designed for educational purposes.

5. The total number of copyright entries made during the quarter under report is 164, including 14 Government publications registered free of charge and nine other works mentioned in the additional list appended to the accompanying catalogue. There have also been four cases of assignment of copyright under Act XX of 1847 in respect of the four books numbered 10, 11, 12 and 13 in this additional list.
