Sir,

I have the honour to refer to G.O. No. 594
Educational dated 25th August 1911, sanction-
ing an enhanced scale of pay till the
31st March 1912 for the coolies employed at
the Marine Aquarium.

2. Even with the higher scale of pay,
much difficulty has been experienced in

obtaining and keeping ²men, and I have
 found it necessary to allow them a further
 increase of eight annas each per mensem
 as compensation for dearness of food. I am
 of opinion that it will not be possible to
 procure able-bodied coolies at the lower
 rates sanctioned in G.O. Mis No. 194 Edu-
 cational dated 3rd April 1911, and for the
 reasons stated in para: 2 of my letter
 disposed of in the G.O. of the 25th August
 last, I have the honour to request that
 Government will be pleased to allow the
 enhanced scale of pay to remain in
force till the close of the ensuing official
year. If this is approved, I shall report
 to Government by the end of January 1913,
 in case it is found necessary to continue
 the higher scale of pay beyond the 31st
 March 1913. Provision having been made
 in the budget estimates of the ensuing
 year for the pay of these coolies at the lower
 rate, I have also the honour to request that
 the necessary alteration may be made in the
 estimates.

The Director applies for the continuance until the 31st March 1913 of the enhanced scale of pay sanctioned for the coolies employed at the Marine ~~xxx~~ Aquarium in G.O. No.594 Edl., dated 25th August 1911. In the circumstances mentioned by the Director, this request may be allowed and he may be told to address govt. in January next, if he considers it necessary to continue the enhanced scale beyond the 31st March 1913.

2. The Director also requests that, if the enhanced scale of pay is sanctioned, the provision made in the budget for the pay of the coolies may be raised. It is now too late to make any alteration in the budget and the Director may be told to meet the extra cost by reappropriation.

3. A draft is submitted for approval. If approved, it may issue with the concurrence of the Finl. dept.

The proposal to continue during 1912 is the subject of the following statement. It is submitted that it is not, as is often said, a question of principle, but a question of fact.

2. Para: 3 of the draft. The extra provision required is only Rs 10, and it is not that the Act-Gen. may be asked on receipt of the educational self-proceedings in the present case to include that amount in the B.E. for 1912-13, and to raise correspondingly the amount included for payable savings so as to leave the total under the minor head "S.C. Scientific & Self-Provisional" unaffected. Para: 3 of the draft may accordingly be omitted.
