I have the honour to submit the enclosed application for grant towards the purchase of furniture, instruments, museum requisites and books for the American Mission College, M a d u r a and to recommend that a grant not exceeding Rs 1,461/- or one half of the entire cost of the articles, whichever may be less, may be sanctioned under articles 57 and 60 of the Grant-in-Aid Code to be paid as funds become available on submission of the necessary vouchers by the correspondent of the college.

2. The correspondent reports that the articles are required for imparting instruction in group II of the Intermediate course which it is proposed to offer from July 1912 and that although the college has already been affiliated to the University in this group it has not been found possible till now to find money to provide the necessary apparatus.

3. As the current year's budget provision for "Grants

for Furniture, Apparatus and other 'special objects' has already been proposed to be fully utilized, the above grant, if sanctioned, will be paid when funds become available probably from the next year's allotment.
