My dear Sir Harold,

My Revenue Head Clerk K.S. Swaminatha

Aiyer has applied to me for permission to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test, Lower Grade, a concession which seems to have been extended to him by Government in 1908 and 1909. He, however, failed to pass on either of these two occasions. He has been temporarily exempted from passing the Criminal Lower Test so as to enable him to fill short vacancies as Sub-Magistrate of Anjengo or Tangasseri and has thus acted for a total period of about 8 months on various occasions. It would be advantageous to have a qualified man in the office to fill up vacancies of Deputy Tahsildars in this district and on this ground alone I request that a further chance may be given to Swaminatha Aiyer to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test, Lower Grade. The open book system introduced since 1910 might help him to get through.

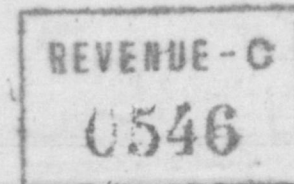
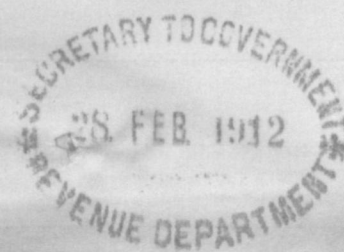
