SIR,

I am directed by the Committee to submit the following for favour of orders of Government.

2. Mrs. Campbell, ~~for~~ 10 years matron in the Military Female Orphan Asylum, Madras, and since the amalgamation of that Institution with the Potacamund Lawrence Asylum, for 8 years Headmatron here, has resigned with effect from 11th February 1912, owing to ill health.

3. Mrs. Campbell has appealed, under these circumstances, for a pension or compassionate allowance.

4. The Committee note that the Provident Fund was introduced in April 1908, and that before that time gratuities were given ranging from 6 to 12 months' salary, and pensions in two very exceptional cases only.

5. If the Provident Fund had been in existence when Mrs. Campbell joined the Military Female Orphan Asylum, she would now be entitled to a gratuity from school funds of about Rs. 418.

6. The Committee therefore recommend that Government be pleased to sanction a gratuity of Rs. 400 from school funds for Mrs. Campbell.
