2. A Ramunni Menon, Permanent clerk on Rs 20-1-25 in
the District Board District Engineer's Office and Ag. Taluk
Board Head Clerk, Wynad on Rs .20-1-30 applies to me to obtain
for him the sanction of Government exempting him from the
general educational qualifications to enable him to appear
for the Revenue, Account and Translation Tests - Lower Grade.

He made the same application to Government in 1909 and was
informed in G.O. No. 94 dated 13-2-09 that his application
could not be considered except on the special recommendation
of the head of his department.

3. He is an unpassed clerk who joined Government service

in 1900. Since then he has been working in several Government offices and is well reported on by the President of the Wynad Taluk Board, who strongly recommends that he should be allowed to appear for the tests specified above. The President writes "A Ramunni Menon left school more than 10 years ago when school leaving certificates were unknown. Having failed at the University Matriculation Examination he had consequently to join Government service as an unpassed candidate. Since the year 1900 he has been working in several Government offices and appears to have given satisfaction. At present he is acting as Taluk Board Head clerk." The clerk I believe is a deserving one, and he desires to better his prospects. I do not know if this is a sufficient ground for granting the permission applied for but as I see from the last pass lists that some unpassed men are allowed to appear I submit the case for the orders of Government.

4. It would be convenient if Government could give me some indication of the criteria to be applied in deciding whether or not such applications should be made.
