Sir,

On behalf of the Basel Mission Educational Council, Calicut registered under the provisions of Section XXVI of the Indian Companies Act, 1882 (cf. G.O. No. 1924, dated 17-12-1903) I beg leave to lay the following petition before you.

The present buildings which are occupied by the B. G. M. College are quite insufficient to accommodate students for the College and High School Departments (the present strength is nearly 900). The University Commission urges me very strongly to proceed with the extension. The Registrar of the University of Madras even asked me in April last to report what progress has been made with the new building of which a plan had been submitted to him. As our Mission intends to raise the Standard of the Second Grade College to that of a First Grade College the Home Committee has already sanctioned funds for the erection of a new building as soon as a suitable site has been secured. The proposed extension should provide room for one large bungalow for Professors and if possible for a second hostel also.

As I find it impossible to secure a suitable site with an indefeasible title I beg to approach you for your kind help in acquiring the site marked "C" in the plan. I cannot

find a better and less objectionable site for the erection of a separate building for the College Department than the land marked "C" (Plan and estimates are now being made). The boundaries of this land are as follows:-

East - Hostel compound.

North - Road connecting Satram and Cannanore Coast Road.

West - Cannanore Road.

South - Compounds belonging to Mussalmans.

"A" refers to the land formerly acquired by the Govt. for the B. G. M. High School, Calicut; "B" shows the land where the present hostel is entertained. As to the land "C" the owner of the northern portion being a Stanom-holder is not in a position to sell the compound as it belongs to Puthia Kovilagam whose management is vested in the Valia Thamburatty for the time being. From the same owner land "A" was acquired by the Government some years ago and made over to the Basel Mission Educational Council.

The southern portion of the land marked "C" belongs to a Mussalman and to a baker Mannan of whom the latter is not willing to part with his property. I should be glad if you could acquire this land also for us.

May I therefore request that you will be so good as to take steps to acquire this land at your early convenience.

I may mention that the acquisition will be at the cost of the Mission. The Basel Mission Educational Council is quite prepared to accede to an agreement with the Secretary of State for India in Council that the site shall not be appropriated for other than educational purposes without the consent of Government and to observe all conditions incidental to this step.
