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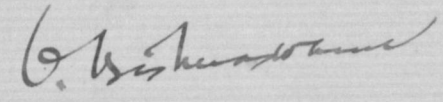

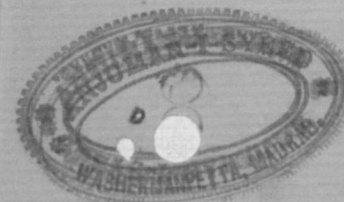
2. The construction of a temporary shed at a cost of Rs 500/- for providing additional accommodation for the combined school pending the construction of a new building will be approved by me.
