Bijan Bee Bee, an assistant in the Government Hobart Training School for Mistresses applied on account of her confinement to the Inspectress of Girls' Schools, Central Circle, for 40 days' privilege leave on half pay from 29th June 1905 to 7th August 1905. The then Inspectress sanctioned however, extraordinary leave without allowances for the teacher. In 1909 the same teacher was again considered aggrieved by leave arrangements occasioned by her confinement. Her husband has accordingly petitioned for a revision of these and also of the Inspectress's decision in 1905. After obtaining the Inspectress's remarks on the appeal, I considered the whole position and converted the leave without allowances granted to the teacher into privilege leave on half pay. As the Inspectress requests, that permission may be granted to draw the leave allowance, I have

the honour to request you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government to permit the Accountant-General to investigate the claim which is 7 years old.
