Sir,

(E) In Government Order No. 773 Misc., dated 24th August 1912, U.A. Abdur Rahim Sahib Bahadur, 4th Class Tahsildar of this district was permitted to appear for the Precise Writing test, though he was not a Graduate. After passing it, he will be eligible to appear for the vernacular test examinations. The recent orders of Government have made it obligatory that only officers who have passed the vernacular test examinations can be recommended for appointment as Deputy Collectors. Thus, U.A. Abdur Rahim Sahib Bahadur can now render himself eligible for appointment by July 1914, provided he passes the precise writing test to be held in October 1913, and both the --- vernacular tests to be held in July 1914. If he should fail in any one of the three tests, his case cannot be

considered until January or July 1915. I enclose a copy of the representation made by the Tahsildar.

In my letter R.C. No. 1445 Ver., dated 23rd July 1912, I reported that I saw no reason why he should be exempted from this test, but I did not realise then that if he is obliged to pass it, his progress will be delayed by a year and that his age does not give it much time. He is now 47 years old and has put in 23 --- years' service. His work is good and I should like therefore to revise my previous recommendation and to recommend that he may be exempted from passing the precis test, and may be allowed to appear for the vernacular tests in June 1913.

To The Collector of Tanjore,

Respected Sir, I submitted an application to you on the 10th of May last (copy herein enclosed) explaining the circumstances under which the Precise Writing test was not compulsory in my case and requesting you to recommend me for exemption from passing that test, in order to enable me to appear for the vernacular tests prescribed for Deputy Collectors--the only tests remaining to be completed by me under the rules. But the Government in its No. 773 Misc., dated 24th August 1912, communicated in Collector's D.Dis. 4608 R. of 1912, dated 14th September 1912, (copy enclosed) was pleased to give me permission to appear for the Precise Writing test at the examination to be held in October 1913 and 1914. The said concession made by the Government will enable me to qualify myself for a Deputy Collector's post only about the middle of 1915 and not before --- that, in case, I pass all the examinations without failure. If I appear for Precise Writing test in October 1913, the result will be known in February 1914 and in July 1914. I can appear for one vernacular, and for second vernacular, I can appear only in January 1915. Added to this there is an additional difficulty with me as a Muhammadan whose mother tongue is Hindiustani in mastering a third language at this advanced age.

2. As I presume, that my services to the Government have received the appreciation of my masters like you and that my promotion in consequence thereof is delayed on account of my not being qualified for it, the concession which the Government has graciously been pleased to grant is one of doubtful benefit to me as I am now 47 years old and as pointed out above, I

shall be eligible to be a Deputy Collector only in my 50th year at the earliest, not to speak of the doubtful chances of passing examinations in due course for some reason or other. But if I am exempted from passing the Precise Writing test I can qualify myself by the middle of next year.

3. I, therefore, humbly request your honour to be graciously pleased to recommend me to Government for exemption from passing the test in order to enable me to appear for one of the vernacular examinations to be held in January next.

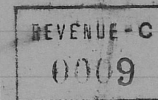
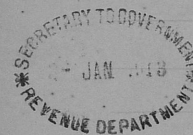
