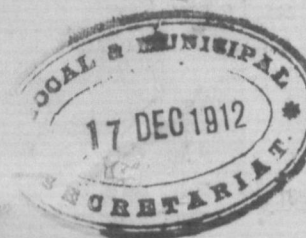

Sir,

I have the honour to submit for the favourable consideration of the Government the application of S. Padmanabha Chari, Clerk, Ramnad Collector's Office, on Rs. 20 requesting that he may be permitted to appear for the Special Test Examinations and declared eligible for promotion to posts on a salary of over Rs. 20 per mensem.

2. S. Padmanabha Chari is a native of Travancore and belongs to the Sholiya Aiyangar caste, a backward class the members of which are ordinarily temple servants. He knows English well, though he has not passed the Matriculation Examination. He also knows Malayalam well. He

has acted as Malayalam Munshi to junior civilians, officers of the Educational Department, and Clergymen in both Malayalam and Tamil. His services are frequently required by my Sub Divisional Magistrates to translate evidence given in Malayalam in their Courts. As Government are aware, the Reserve Police in Ramnad are largely Malayalis. Travancore people also sometimes figure as witnesses or parties in cases in this district. He is a very intelligent young man and would, I gather, have been appointed as a probationary Sub Inspector in the Police, but that his eyesight was found to be defective. He is also physically active and rides a cycle. I have found him far more intelligent and helpful in many ways than clerks with better paper qualifications. In the Ramnad district a sensible and trustworthy clerk is a Godsend.

3. In these circumstances I request that the Government will be pleased to permit him to appear for the Special Test Examinations and also to declare him eligible to hold posts carrying more than Rs. 20. I consider that it is distinctly in the public interests to encourage this stamp of man.

HONOURED SIR,

I beg to submit the following lines to your honour's kind consideration.

I am a native of Travancore. I have a fair knowledge of English and Special proficiency in Malayalam. Prior to my joining the service, I coached several civilian officers, officers of the educational department, clergymen and other European gentlemen in Malayalam and Tamil. All of them have passed Vernacular tests remarkably well. Mr. J.F. Bryant, recognising my capacity for work and integrity, appointed me as a permanent clerk on Rs. 20/-.

I have on several occasions been deputed to the Courts of European Sub Divisional Magistrates to interpret the language of the Court to the parties and vice versa, without any extra remuneration.

In fine, I beg to request that I may be exempted from the disabilities attendant on the Public Service Notification and permitted to apply to the Special Test Examinations and appointed to posts conveying more than Rs. 20/-

In view of the strong recommendation of the collector the exemption applied for may perhaps be granted. The remarks of the Revenue Department may be obtained no.

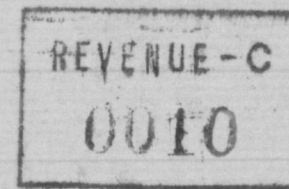
