the Chief Secretary to the Government of Madras.

AS I am informed that the Government have resolved upon introducing into schools in this Presidency religious and moral instruction to be imparted side by side with secular one, I beg to forward to you one set by separate packet of ten books compiled and published by my late father Mr. R. Sivasankara Pandiyaji, B.A., President and founder of the Hindu Theological High School, Madras, with the view of getting them prescribed in all schools from the lowest standards to the highest forms in connection with the said religious and moral instruction.

Incidentally, I beg to mention that as per enclosure (1) herein the aforesaid books graduated as they are have been -- prescribed in the Madras Hindu Theological High School and other schools as text books for the different standards and forms and that the same was adopted by the same Hindu Theological Committee in consultation with and with the approval of the distinguished pandits and graduates of India mentioned in enclosure (II) appended herein, and that the said books are on non-sectarian basis.

Further I beg to send enclosed herein for your information copies of testimonials on some of the above books given by several gentlemen of high rank and position such as, the Right Honourable Mr. Gladstone, the distinguished Prime Minister of England, His Excellency Lord Reay, G.C.I.E., Governor of Bombay, the Hon'ble Rev. William Miller, M.A., D.D., C.I.E., the Hon'ble W.W. Hunter, L.L.D., C.I.E., President of the Education Commission, Calcutta, the Hon'ble Justice Sir Gurudas Bannerjee, M.A., L.L.D., K.C.S.I., late Vice-Chancellor of the University of Calcutta, the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Telang, M.A., L.L.B., Dr. D. Duncan, M.A., D.Sc., late Director of Public Instruction, Madras, Rajah Sir Surendar Mohan Tagore, K.C.I.E., Rajah Sir T. Madhava Rao, K.C.S.I., the Hon'ble Mr. N. Haridas B.A., L.L.B., and several others.
