G.O. No. 896, Educational, dated 9th October 1912.

ABSTRACT.—Replacing both the higher and lower grades of the Account Test by a single test to be called the Account test and permitting the paper on the Civil Account Code being answered with the aid of the Code and its index.

With reference to G.O. No. 896, Educational, dated 9th October 1912, I have the honour to submit, for approval and publication in the *Fort St. George Gazette*, a draft, in duplicate, of the alterations to be made in the Public Service and Special Test Notifications.

2. In both the notifications, the entry "Revenue Inspectors (including Land Records Inspectors)" appears against Account Test, Lower grade. I made a reference to the Board of Revenue as to whether the Land Records Inspectors are also to be excluded from liability to pass the Account Test and the reply of the Board is in the affirmative. I have made the alterations accordingly in the draft now submitted.

The following notification will be published in the *Fort St. George Gazette* :—

NOTIFICATION.

I. The following changes are directed in the Special Test Notification published at pages 336 to 346 of Part I-B of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated 21st May 1912 :—

(a) In Article 1, in the list of the special tests, the words "Higher grade" in item (4) and item (5) shall be omitted, the remaining items in the list being renumbered.

(b) In Article 5, the words "Higher grade" occurring in the heading "Account Test, Higher grade," and the heading "Account Test, Lower grade" as well as the entries under the latter shall be omitted.

(c) In Article 6, the words "the Account Test" shall be inserted between the words "Certain papers in" and "the Civil Judicial Test, etc.," occurring in the second sentence.

(d) In Article 11, in the table appended to it, the words "Higher grade" after the words "Account Test" in column 1 shall be omitted, the words "(With books)" shall be added after the word "Do." in column 3 against the words "The Civil Account Code, Volume I" in column 2 and the words "Two hours" shall be substituted for the word "Do." in column 3 against the words "The Civil Service Regulations" in column 2, and the entry "Account Test, Lower grade" in column 1 as well as the entries against it in columns 2, 3 and 4 shall be omitted.

(e) In Article 12, the entry "In the Account Test, Lower grade, 40 per cent. of the maximum marks" shall be deleted.

(f) In Article 17, the words "Higher grade" in item 4 and item "5. The Account Test, Lower grade . . . 4" shall be omitted, the remaining items being renumbered.

(g) In Article 18, in the schedule attached to it, the words "Higher grade" after the words "Account Test" in column 1 and the word "Higher" after the words "Account Test" in the Remarks column against Account Test, Higher grade, shall be omitted, the entry "Account Test, Lower grade" in column 1 and the entry against it in the Remarks column shall be deleted; the words "except Revenue Inspectors (including Land Records Inspectors)" shall be added after the words "Revenue Test, Lower grade" in item 1 in column 2—the asterisk being omitted; item 2 in column 2 against the existing entry "Account Test, Lower grade" shall be deleted, and items "1" and "3" shall be numbered as items "19" and "20" respectively; in the footnote relating to the Account Test, the words "Higher grade" occurring in the first sentence shall be omitted; in the second item in the Remarks column, against "Revenue Test, Lower grade" the word "Test" shall be substituted for the words "and Account Tests."

II. The following changes are directed in the Public Service Notification published at pages 323 to 336 of Part I-B of the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated 21st May 1912 :—

(i) In Article 3, in the table showing the various offices in "superior service" for which special, professional or technical tests are prescribed, the words "Higher grade" and the words "Lower grade" appearing after "Account Test" and the word "do." denoting the grade occurring after "Account Test" and after the "Do." denoting this test shall be omitted.

Under "C. Revenue Department," the words "Account Test do." in column 2 against item (13) shall be deleted.

Under "I. Jail Department," the words "Account Test, Lower grade" in column 2 against items (1) and (2) shall be omitted.

(ii) In Article 5, in clauses (4) and (5) the word "Test" shall be substituted for the words "and Account Tests."

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SECRETARIAT.

(a) If a paper is marked to be printed urgently, the Superintendent of the section concerned should sign the Press slip. The Superintendent should exercise a careful discretion in the matter.

(b) Each letter, memorandum, or order, or set of orders, in the file of correspondence should be headed in succession with the Roman numeral I, II, III, etc., the number being written in red ink or blue chalk above the item. The particular papers to be printed in the special issue-copies should be indicated by the Roman numeral (I, II, etc.) by which that item has been headed in the correspondence file. All matter, including marginal remarks or references, to be printed should be written in ink and matter which should not be printed should be encircled. Initials and signatures that are not quite legible should be re-written distinctly.

(b¹) For rules regarding printing of notes, see the rules in G.O., No. 1220, Public, dated 30th November 1900.

(c) The number of copies and the details of distribution should be filled in by the Superintendent or Referencer concerned.

(d) In the absence of special instructions to the Press to keep matter standing for a specified period, ordinary papers of 8 pages and under will be kept standing for one week, and larger papers for two weeks only. The type of notes and of all confidential papers is distributed immediately after striking.

(e) This slip, properly and completely filled in, should accompany every paper sent to Press; it will be returned by the Press when proofs are furnished; it should be sent to the Press when a call is made for revised proofs or when a corrected proof is sent for striking. When finally returned by Press it should be filed with the original order or letter.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PRESS.

(a) If, in the opinion of the Superintendent of the Press, a paper has been marked urgent unnecessarily, he should send the Press slip to the Deputy Registrar with a remark to that effect.

(b) Unless a note to the contrary is made against the matter, pencil entries should not be printed. The Superintendent of the Press may bring to the notice of the Deputy Registrar any instance of incomplete or careless editing.

(c) Signature copies of letters to the Secretary of State or to the Government of India should be printed on hand-made paper.

(d) This slip should be returned by the Press to the Secretariat when proofs are furnished; it will be sent back to the Press when proofs are returned corrected and should be finally returned to the Secretariat when struck-off copies are supplied.

(e) The names of the Secretary and Members should be printed in full when they occur on the right hand side, but only the first time when they appear on the left side, the initials alone being printed later.
