The Govt of India requests to be informed

- (1) whether Mr. Mayhew's services can be spared for the acting appointment proposed & if so,
- (2) whether Mr. Mayhew is prepared to accept it.

Mr. Stone deals with the first point but not with the second. It is for consideration whether the D.P.I. may be asked to ascertain from Mr. Mayhew if he is prepared to accept the acting appointment offered by the Govt of India.

2. For the inspection of Chiefs' Colleges Mr. Mayhew's name has been suggested only tentatively. Please see papers with G.O. no. 44 Edl dated 16-1-13. For that work the services of an officer is required for two months in March and April. For the acting appointment in the N.W.P. an officer is required from the 31st March next. One
