I have the honour to state that Mr. R.D. Mathias, who is now an Assistant Auditor of Local Fund Accounts, Accountant-General's Office, Madras, and Mr. Charles Xavier, who is now attending the First-in-Arts Class at the Central College, Bangalore, have applied for admission to the Government Training Class for male teachers in European Schools at Sanawar. I beg to request the sanction of Government for payment to these two candidates of the stipend at the prescribed rate of Rs. 40/- a month each and of the 2nd class railway fares to and from Sanawar.
