I have the honour to submit for favour of orders an application in prescribed form to exempt A.Lutchmiah - Nayudu, from the examination rules to allow him to hold the appointment of 2nd Mechanic at the Agricultural College, Coimbatore, which exemption to take effect from 30th October 1912.

Competent mechanic at the College to attend to the oil engines etc. and applications were invited in the Gazette and otherwise for the post. In the first place a passed man was selected and tried, but the District Medical and Sanitary Officer declined to give him a health certificate. Mr. Wood wrote to several of the other applicants but those who were qualified by examination rules and were willing to come lacked experience or failed to produce satisfactory references. This man was selected from the Railway Workshops, Perambur, through the kindness and help of Mr. Sampson's brother who is an Engineer on the Railway. He has had 13 years experience as a fitter in the Railway Workshops and has now been tried for some weeks at Coimbatore where his work is satisfactory. I have seen him at work myself and he appears to be both intelligent and competent. The delay in applying for exemption is due to correspondence owing to ordering him to appear before the District Medical and Sanitary Officer and obtain a certificate of medical fitness before troubling the Board with this reference and to the inadvisability of working the Engines at Coimbatore without a competent man in charge. The District Medical and Sanitary Officer has passed him as fit.

Reference thereon No. 140, dated 20th January 1913.

In his letter read above the Director of Agriculture requests that A. Lutchmiah Nayudu may be permanently exempted from the examination rules in order to enable him to hold the post of second mechanic created in G.O. Mis. No. 1807 Rev., dated 19th June 1912. In the circumstances explained, the Board supports the request and submits that the exemption applied for may be sanctioned and that it may take effect from 30th October 1912.
