The sanction accorded in G.O. No. 114 Edl.,

dated 25th March 1912 to the retention of the temporary additional teacher on Rs.20/- per mensem in the Government Girls' School, Bhavani, having expired with the 31st March 1913, the Inspectress recommends the permanent retention of the teacher, and the employment of an additional temporary teacher on Rs.10/- per mensem for the charge of an extra section of the infant standard. She reports that the present

I consider the Inspectress's proposals to be reasonable though pending the general re-organization of all the Government Girls' schools which is under my consideration the additional teacher on Rs.20/- may in my opinion continue to be on a temporary footing for another year. Accordingly, I beg to recommend that sanction be accorded to the continuance of the temporary teacher on Rs.20/- per mensem, for another year from 1st April 1913 and to the employment of an extra temporary teacher on Rs.10/- per mensem for a period of one year from the 15th July next.

2. Provision for the temporary teacher on Rs.20/- exists in the budget estimate for the current year and I submit herewith a re-appropriation statement for meeting the extra charge on account of the additional teacher on Rs.10/- whose employment is now proposed.

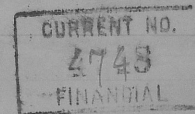
