With profound respects and
humble obedience I most respectfully beg
your gracious Excellency's permission to
approach your gracious Excellency in Council
as follows: -

2. My son Muhammad
Shahid Jaffer Sahib is reading in the
Municipal High School Kurnool. He was
not given less promotion in the last year.

from the 1st term to the
considering his attendance period was
not sufficient in the last school year.

3 In this affair the
Director of Public Instruction has prom-
it following order in his enclosed proceeding
Dec 18 1872 11/13 dated 18.7.72, and I
respectfully submit ^{to you} as appeal against this order.
"No exemption from the production of
the attendance certificate can be granted
and Abdul Jaffer is therefore ineligible
for promotion".

4. The short attendance of
my son Mohammed Abdul Jaffer
in the school during the last school year
was due to his fall from a bridge
and consequent necessity to meet an
operation and as such he was then
bed-ridden. Thus under such an
unavoidable circumstance he was not able
to attend the school, during the days of
his inability to walk, for a portion of the
first school term in the last school year in
the beginning of 1st year. To cover the

period of his absence. His
medical certificates were sent then
to the Head Master. Recovery
leave applications were also sent
then to the Head Master for the
same. School fees for the period of
his absence were also then paid
monthly. He rejoined the school as soon
as he was able to stand and walk.
He was admitted in the half yearly
examination and in the annual exami-
nation too. He studied hard and secured
such marks in the annual class
promotion examination that your
Gracious Excellency - in - Council will
find that even those who got less
number of marks than the number he
secured in the annual examination
got promotion to the IV Form from the IVth

5. Thus your Gracious
Excellency in Council will find that
his short attendance was due to
an ~~unavoidable~~ accident and that

is no ^{an error}
make him eligible for promotion
for his absence under unavoidable
circumstances affected his efficiency
for promotion.

b. If your Excellency
in Council will send for my petition
dated 19-6-13 presented to the
Director of Public Instruction and
my petition dated 2-7-13 submitted
to the Inspector of Schools District Circular
all the connected papers and in
consider this case and also if necessary
will refer the matter to the Final
Examination Committee and to the
Adviser to the Government of India
in the Educational Department, if
your Excellency in Council will be
that justice demands the interposition
of your Excellency in Council in the
case to promote my son to the 1st B.
your Excellency in Council may also
be aware that such ^{exemptions} ~~advantages~~ were

granted even for admission into the
higher University Examinations. In the
case of my son, he was admitted
into the class promotion annual
examination, and it is for your
Honour's Excellency in Council to decide
how his promotion can be hindered, for
justice sake, after such an admission
when promotion was given to those
who got less marks than him
in the same annual class promotion
examination.

7. I therefore pray your
Honour's Excellency in Council to
do justice and promote my son,
as your Excellency in Council is the
"Father of Youth, Education, Mercy
& Justice;" and thus encourage
my son towards higher education.
