Read letter from E.B.Elwin, Esq, I.C.S., Collector of
Godavari, D.Dis No.634 /For. 13 dated 14th May 1913:--

I have the honour to recommend Y.V.Rama Dass, 2nd clerk
and D.Lakshmana Dass 3rd clerk of the District Forest Office,
Upper Godavari for a further extension of time by 2 years i.e.
up to 1914 to enable them to pass the examination in Account

Test Higher Grade, as they have been unsuccessful in passing the examination within the period fixed generally for all clerks in District Forest Offices (Please vide B.P.F. No. 40 dated 16-2-10). Rama Dass has 7 years' service in the Department 5 of which were spent in the District Forest Office where he acted as Accountant on more than one occasion and for which he was exempted once in B.P.F.Mis. No.136 dated 30-1-13. He is now drawing Rs.25-1-30.

Lakshmana Dass has 5 years' service in the Department and is at present the Camp clerk on a salary of Rs.20-1-25.

Both the men are non-Brahmins and residents of Bhadrachalam and are therefore very suitable for employment in the Agency tracts of which the Division consists. The District Forest Officer recommends the extension on the ground that they have been working satisfactorily and deserve to be given another chance.
