With reference to paragraph 3 of G.O. The Inspector of Schools for the time being of the Eighth Circle or of such other circle in which Calicut shall at any time hereafter be included and the Headmaster for the time being of the Government School of Commerce at Calicut shall be the administrators of the said "Kaviraj Vidvan Manavikrama Ettan Raja Prize Endowment Fund" and the securities and money which were vested in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments by notification No. 125, dated the 26th day of August 1913.

2. From and out of the interest accruing on the said "Kaviraj Vidvan Manavikrama Ettan Raja Prize Endowment Fund" shall be provided annually a prize which shall be called "Kaviraj Vidvan Manavikrama Ettan Raja Prize" and the said prize shall be in the form of books on commercial subjects selected by the Headmaster for the time being of the said Government School of Commerce, Calicut.

(a) If a paper is marked to be printed urgently, the Superintendent of the section concerned should sign the Press slip. The Superintendent should exercise a careful discretion in the matter.

(b) Each letter, memorandum, or order, or set of orders, in the file of correspondence should be headed in succession with the Roman numeral I, II, III, etc., the number being written in red ink or blue chalk above the item. The particular papers to be printed in the special issue-copies should be indicated by the Roman numeral (I, II, etc.) by which that item has been headed in the correspondence file. All matter, including marginal remarks or references, to be printed should be written in ink and matter which should not be printed should be encircled. Initials and signatures that are not quite legible should be re-written distinctly.
