Copy of letter from the District Judge of North Arcot, to the Registrar, High Court, Madras, No. 3320, dated 26th July 1913.

3-5CP I have the honour to forward herewith a petition to His Excellency the Governor in Council, dated the 12th April 1913, (received in this Court only on the 21st instant) from N.S. Venkoba Rao, 6th clerk of the District Munsif's Court, Madanapalle, praying that, in the circumstances therein stated, he may be exempted from passing the matriculation examination and permitted to appear for the Civil Judicial and Translation Lower Tests.

2. The petitioner was appointed as a permanent clerk in 1911 and appears to have been employed as an acting clerk off and on for about 2 years previously. The District Munsif of Madanapalle (M.R. Ry. B. Rama Rao Avargal) states that during all this time the petitioner also did the work of a typist using his own machine; that he is intelligent and hardworking and takes great interest in his work, and that in his opinion the petitioner will be found fit for appointments carrying higher emoluments and involving greater responsibilities.

p4 in fra 3. The only grounds put forward by the petitioner for exemption are those set forth in paragraph 4 of the petition.

4. I do not think that the length of petitioner's service or the grounds put forward by him ~~in~~ entitle him to any special consideration at the hands of Government.

The humble petition of N.S. Venkoba Rau permanent
6th clerk, District Munsiff's Court, Madanapalle, most --
respectfully sheweth:---

1. That your humble petitioner is a permanent 6th clerk
on Rs. 20/-, and has put in a service of about two years --
during which he has given entire satisfaction to his --
superiors in all respects.

2. That your humble petitioner passed the Government
Lower Secondary Examination in 1902 with Telugu as his
optional language, and the Government Technical Examination
in Type-writing Elementary Grade; that he also studied upto
the Matriculation Standard, having twice appeared for the
Matriculation Examination though unsuccessfully; and that
he was obliged to discontinue his studies on account of his

straitsened circumstances.

3. That your humble petitioner was until recently the only non-brahmin, clerk in the Clerical Establishment of the Court.

4. That your humble petitioner is a Mahratta non-Brahmin 25 years old and belongs to a respectable Mahratta family whose ancestors are the direct descendants of the ancient and famous Mahratta Families who settled down in Southern India in the 18th century; and that his paternal grand-father was the Head Clerk of the District Munsiff's Court of Kadiri.

5. That your humble petitioner is anxious to appear for and pass the Judicial & Translation Lower Tests, so that he may aspire to higher appointments in the Department; the fact however, that he has not been so fortunate as to pass the Matriculation Examination stands in his way; but this difficulty can be surmounted if your Excellency should condescend to take the peculiar circumstances of the --- petitioner's case into consideration and graciously exempt him from passing the Matriculation Examination and accord him permission to appear for the Civil Judicial and Translation Lower Tests.

6. Your humble petitioner therefore prays that Your Excellency may be graciously pleased to exempt him from passing the Matriculation Examination and grant him permission to appear for the Civil Judicial Test and the --- Translation Lower Test.

For this act of kindness and justice the petitioner

shall as in duty bound ever pray.
