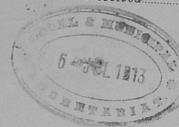

I have the honour to request that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for the employment with effect from 1st July next of a night watchman on Rs.6 per mensem in the office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools, South Arcot district.

2. The office of the Assistant Inspector is at present held in a private building rented for Rs.15 per mensem but as the Executive Engineer has now placed at his disposal a public building the office has to be removed to it. The Assistant Inspector states that it is at the

farthest end of the town - opposite the Traveller's Bungalow in Manjakoppam - without the protection of a compound wall or fence and that a nightwatchman is absolutely necessary to look after the records and furniture in the building during the ~~xx~~ night time. The Inspector recommends the proposal.

3. The charge will be met from the contingent allotment provided for house rent for the Assistant Inspector's office.

With reference to Government Memo. No. 2088-1 Edl. dated 25th July 1913, I have the honour to state that excluding the Office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools, South Arcot District there are 22 offices of Assistant Inspector of Schools out of which sixteen are held in private rented buildings which are not guarded at nights, and the remaining six in public buildings. Of the latter four have no provision for nightwatchmen and in the case of the other two, the office of the Assistant Inspector, Bellary, which is located in the corner of the Fort where there is a little security is guarded at nights by the office sweeper who not only cleans the office but also guards it and the local Sub Assistant's office which

copies a portion of the same building, and the office of the Assistant Inspector, Chingleput District, which is located in the Old College compound, pays a contribution of As.8/- per mensem towards the salary of the night-watchman sanctioned in G.O. No.736 Edl. dated 23rd October 1911.

one peon for the office at head-

for at least 180 days in the year there
will be only one peon in office for

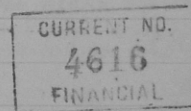
