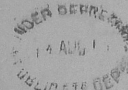

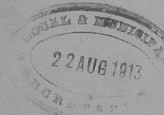

I have the honour to submit an application from one Muhammad Munawar praying for exemption from the provisions of article 1 of the Public Service Notification and from the operation of para 3 of G.O. No. 682, Rev., dated 11th March 1911.

2. Muhammad Munawar is the only son of Muhammad Anwar-ud-din Khan Sahib, a Carnatic Stipendiary drawing a perpetual stipend of Rs.125 per mensem, Private Secretary to the Prince of Arcot and son of the late Bashir-un-nisa Begam Sahiba, a Shadi daughter of Prince Zahir-ud-daulah and an adopted daughter of Prince Azim Jah. The applicant is aged 21 years, has studied up to the Matriculation standard, has a fair knowledge of English and has the last



last four months acted in the Office of the Superintendent of Stationery as a clerk on Rs.20/-. Exemptions of the kind requested by the applicant were sanctioned by Government in favour of Muhammad Niaz Husain and Muhammad Inayath Husain, nikahi grandsons of Prince Zahir-ud-daulah, and Muhammad Zain-ul-abidin, a great grandson of Nawab Azim-ud-daulah, the last in G.O. No. 497, Misc., Educational, dated 2nd June 1913. I beg to recommend that Government be pleased to accord a similar exemption to Muhammad Munawar.

The humble Memorial of Mahomed Munawar submitted through R.F. Austin, Esq., I.C.S., Paymaster and Collector of Madras.

Most respectfully sheweth :-

That the memorialist is a great grandson of H.H. Nawab Zahiruddoula Bahadur, G.C.S.I., 2nd Prince of Arcot, and the son of Khan Sahib Mahomed Anwaruddin Sahib Bahadur, Private Secretary to the present Prince of Arcot and Ex-Sheriff of Madras.

2. That your Excellency's memorialist is at present employed as a clerk under the Collector of Madras and is discharging his duties in that capacity to the entire satisfaction of his superior officers.

3. That your memorialist has received instruction up to Matriculation standard but was unable to continue further owing to diverse causes beyond his control.

4. That your memorialist family ranks second to none in respectability in Southern India and his father's services to the Government and to the Musalman public as Secretary to Aijuman A-Mufid-Ahal-A-Islam at Madras earned him the personal distinction of "Khan Sahib" and were recognized by the Madras government and in a practical manner by his appointment to the Sirivality of Madras in the year 1903.

5. Encouraged by the action of the benign government of Madras by exempting Musalman young men of decent birth from the provisions

provisions of article 1 of Public Service Notification,, the memorialist most respectfully begs to approach Your Excellency with this his humble memorial and prays that a similar consideration be accorded to him in exempting him from the provisions of article I of Public Service Notification and from operation of para 3 of G.O. No.682 Revenue dt: 11-3-1911 so that he may earn his promotion in Government service and qualify himself for better posts by passing the Special Test Examinations for which he cannot now appear without the necessary qualifying examinations for which act of benevolence and charity Your Excellency's humble memorialist will as in duty bound ever pray for your Excellency's long life and prosperity.

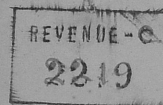

- 3) Muhammad Iqbal-ul-abidin Co. 497 Ed. of 2.6.13

These men were also exempted from the operation of para 3 of G.O. No. 682 Rev. of 11.3.11 in order to enable them to enter the Upper Division in the orders noted in the margin.

M^r. Austin recommends that a similar exemption may be accorded to Muhammad Munawar who is also a member of the Kanab
