The teacher was first exempted by the Director temporarily until the publication of the results of the Preliminary Examination for Teachers' Certificate of the Secondary grade held in February 1913. The Inspector of Girls' Schools, Central Circle reports that qualified Muhammadan Mistresses of the secondary grade are not available and that European or Hindu mistresses could not be obtained for such a low pay as Rs.20-1-25 and requests that permanent exemption may be granted in view of the satisfactory work of the teacher. I beg to support her proposal subject to the condition that the teacher should not be allowed to rise to a higher rate of pay than Rs.25 per mensem without further sanction.
