In G. O. No. 588 Mis. Educational, dated 14th

October 1910 sanction was accorded to the employment of a Commercial Instructor on Rs. 60/- per mensem in the Government Madrasa-i-Azam for a period of one year from 1st March 1911^{or} until the receipt of sanction to the scheme for the establishment of Model Secondary schools. The Headmaster of the School did not apply for the continuance of the post after 1st March 1912

as

as he was under the impression that further sanction was not necessary pending the issue of final orders on the Model School Scheme. As the Accountant General considers that fresh sanction is necessary for the retention of the post after 1st March 1912, I have the honour to request that you will be so good as to accord sanction for the retention of the instructor from 1st March 1912 until the 28th February 1914 or until the introduction of the modified scheme called for by Government for the establishment of Model Secondary Schools, whichever is earlier.

The necessary provision exists in the current

year's budget.
