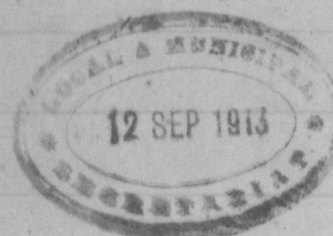
Hon. Mr. Harold Stuart.

The Educational Secy. who writes the above, has changed his mind. - When I consulted him before on the point, he thought I did need not be asked, & I regret that I did not examine the position. If the grant had been only a two-thirds, instead of a full - grant, the case need not have gone to Finance; nor need it if it had been a grant for hostels - even if it had been a full grant. As the matter stands, I now think I should have been consulted. I am afraid I was thinking less of the rules than of the facts that there is hardly any money in the Budget & that the C.O.A. are very deserving & very poor.

In Go. No. 702 Educl of 31.7.13, Government have sanctioned a grant not exceeding Rs 46,910 towards the cost of construction of certain additional buildings for the Civil Orphan Asylum, Madras. The payment will presumably be made by the Director of Public Instruction who has stated that a large part of the grant may be paid during the current year (1913-14) from the special allotments (in the budget) available for European schools. It is not known how much will be paid during the current year and how much in 1914-15.

It is submitted that the order should, as observed by H. M., have been sent to this department for acceptance — vide Rules 7(vii) and 7(vii) (b) of the rules regulating inter-departmental references.

2. In this connection attention is solicited to the remarks of the Educational dept. at A and B on pages 2 and 3 ante, viz. that grants for hostels, in excess of the maximum limit of one-half of the cost laid down in the Educational grant-in-aid code, need not be sent to Financial, and the authority quoted is the notes to G.O. 448 Educl of 15.5.13.

3 Under rules 7(v)(2) and 7(vii) of the rules regulating interdepartmental references, these cases should, it is submitted, be sent to Financial for acceptance. It is not clear whether G.O. 448 Educl of 15.5.13 was accepted in Financial, it was the intention that individual cases need not be sent to Financial. The question whether the distribution of the lump sum provisions made in the budget for grants to local bodies may be

As regards the grant to the C.O.A. I sympathize with Mr Francis' remarks, but I think the full grant should be provided for this year, & not left as a liability for the future. The Educ. Dept may be asked to debit this grant of Rs. 46910 agst the grants of the year & to inform the D.P.D. at an early date, so that he may recognize the liability the reduction in the sums at his disposal.

H.F. 2. G.O. N^o 448 Ed. 15.5.13 was not accepted in Fm. All that we agreed to was to consider applications without strict regard to the terms of the Grant. in Aid Code. ~~The G.O. should not be decided to the extent of a full case~~ I think it should be the rule that each case in which the grant is not in accordance with the Code regulations should be sent to Fm.

A draft order in accordance with the Chief Secretary's note is submitted for approval.

2. It is, however, submitted that under art. 62 of the Code of Regulations for European Schools ~~the full payment of the grant can be made only after the completion of the buildings though advances may be made from time to time if the Director is satisfied that the work is proceeding satisfactorily. To facilitate the payment of the entire amount it is proposed in the draft order to call on the D.O.D to hurry up the management to have the building completed within the year.~~

3. With reference to para. 2 of the Chief Secretary's note, it is submitted that the draft of G.O. 448 of 15.5.13 was in accordance with the decision of the Financial Dept. as indicated in the notes on page 3 of the notes to that G.O. and under rule 3 of the rules for interdepartmental references it did not require that department's acceptance. As already stated in para. 3 of this office note on page 2 rule the Financial Dept's assent to the general principle has been taken by Educational as sufficient authority for
