2nd May 1912. It was thought ^{that} as the stipend due for
March 1912 must be paid in April 1912 the enhanced
rate of stipend might be considered to have effect
from 1st March 1912. There was no later G.O.

(I) The enhanced rates of stipends sanctioned in G.O., No.378 Educational, dated 2nd May 1912 were ordered to take effect from 1st April 1912, but the Director of Public Instruction brought the new rates into operation from 1st March 1912 under the impression that as the stipend due for March 1912 must be paid in April 1912 the enhanced rate of stipend might be considered to have effect from 1st March 1912. As G.O., No.378 Edl., dated 2nd May 1912 has not however been subsequently modified, it would seem necessary to validate the D.P.I.'s action. Submitted that the case may be forwarded to the Educational Department after the draft order issues.

It is not clear whether the increased rates were actually paid from 1st March 1912 to all stipendiaries in Government elementary schools and grants at enhanced rates disbursed to all aided training schools from that date. If it had been, the Accountant-General would have raised objections. Before taking further action it is submitted that the Director of Public Instruction may be requested to u.o. to state whether the facts are as above, and why effect was given to the G.O., a month earlier.

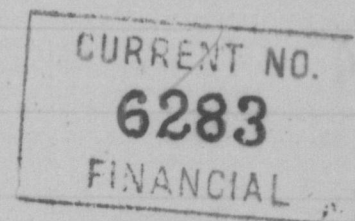

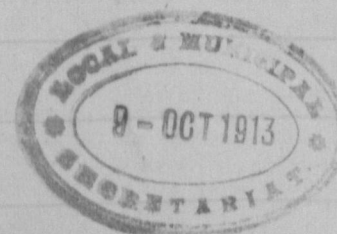
