In an exactly similar case from the same District (Trinnevelly) the Government permitted the applicant to appear for Criminal Judicial test, higher grade. The applicant in that case was however a member of the Backward Community of shepherds - for 700 Ed. by 30.7.13.

2. Padmanabha Ayyar, the present applicant, can be appointed a Dy. Tahsildar at present only if the Collector certifies that his merits are such that the interests of the District administration will be distinctly promoted by his appointment. If the applicant passes the Criminal Judicial test, higher grade, such a Certificate would not be necessary for his appointment as Dy. Tahsildar. Criminal judicial test, lower grade, is one of the tests prescribed for the post of By. Tahsildar. Only J.A's are allowed to appear for this test. The applicant is a matriculate and in 1903 Govt. permitted him to appear for this test. He has passed this test. Thus by the Concession allowed in 1903 the applicant may be appointed a By. Tahsildar if the Colr. Certifies that his merits are such that the interests of the district Administration will be ~~distinctly~~ distinctly promoted by his appointment as By. Tahsildar. Such a Certificate would not have helped him in getting a By. Tahsildar's post had it not been for the Concession of 1903.

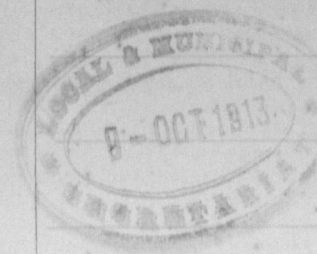
