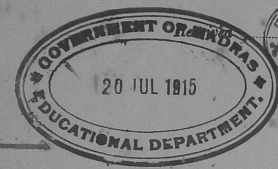

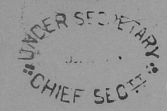

Requirements of Trichur Cotton mills.

The Resident states that he is not in a position to furnish the Trichur mill ~~and~~ information as to why the names of the British exporting firms and other particulars relating to its requirements are required by the Govt. It is submitted that these were called for by the Govt of India with a view to address the Secretary of State to make arrangements to meet the demand for articles, required for textile mills in this country, which are prohibited from export from the United Kingdom. This was communicated to the Resident in Govt memo No. 1950 A/14-4 Revenue dated the 7th November 1914. The attention of the Resident may, it is submitted, be
