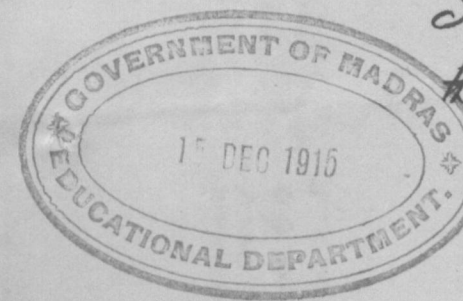

(C) 1914-15- please see paragraph 4 of the D.P.D.'s endorsement on page 3 of L.P. no. 399 M, dated the 26th February 1914. The sanctioned grant of Rs. 1,582, together with the savings due to the transfer of the payment of grants-in-aid to private schools from municipal to provincial funds, will more than cover the cost of the new schools opened with the help of Provincial grants. 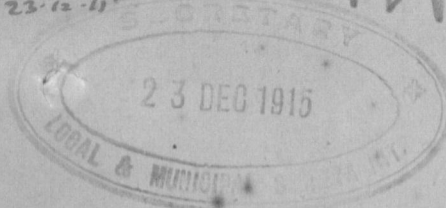

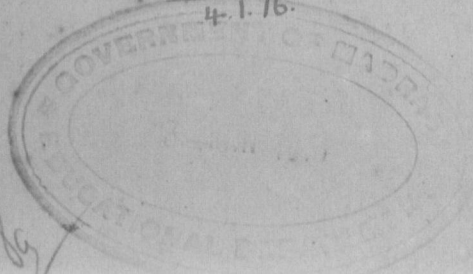
